



GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

TUESDAY, MARCH 11, 2008

March 2008 is just around the corner and with that comes election time. The *General Municipal Election* will occur on **Tuesday, March 11th**. On the ballot for that election will be candidates running for Commissioners in District 2 and 4. In the event a candidate runoff is required, that election will be held Tuesday, April 15th. All elections are held between the hours of 7:00am and 7:00pm in accordance with state law and all districts vote in the Community Center located at One Park Place.

Anyone interested in becoming a candidate in Districts 2 or 4 must live within the district he/she wishes to run. All candidates must be registered electors of the City.

Qualifying for candidacy begins at noon on December 19th and ends at noon on January 2nd. Qualifying papers are available in the office of the City Clerk. Voter registration books close on February 11th for the March 11th election and March 17th for the April 15th runoff.
