- a) **PZ-2006-19-SR:** Site Plan Review at 9560 West Gulf Boulevard to allow the construction of single family structure. *Commercial General (CG). Special Exception granted PZ-2004-37-SE.*
- b) **PZ-2006-10-VR-T:** Variance requests at 10133 Gulf Boulevard to construct a dock that exceeds the allowable length and height above the seawall cap. *Resort Facilities Medium (RFM-30). Tabled due to applicant's failure to provide certificate of mailings (Sec. 70-12).*
- c) **PZ-2006-18-VR-T:** Variance request at 368 Bay Plaza to allow the placement of two tie poles beyond the dock structure in a manner that exceeds the overall length allowed. *Residential Medium (RM-15).*
- d) **PZ-2006-20-VR:** Variance request at 279-104<sup>th</sup> Avenue to construct a dock and boat lifts that extend into side yard setback area. *Resort Facilities Medium (RFM-30).*

Communications between board members and public. Said transcript shall be made by the appellant at his or her expense. The City maintains a tape recording of all public hearings. In the event that you wish to appeal a decision, the tape may or may not adequately insure a verbatim record of the proceedings. Therefore, you may wish to provide a court reporter at your expense.
