#### Synopsis:

Between the above times, person(s) unknown removed two lawn decorations from the front yard of a residence. The lawn decorations are described as a white colored cement “Lord Ganesha” statue with an elephant face. 18-24” and the second decoration is described as a brown colored Iguana Lizard ornament, approximately 10-12” long.

Example of a “Lord Ganesha” statue- not the one stolen, but describes the features. A google search states “Lord Ganesha” is the elephant-deity riding a mouse — has become one of the most common mnemonics for anything associated with Hinduism.
