TI Causeway Bridge closed July 30th to August 1st

The Treasure Island Causeway Bridge will be closed for three days beginning **Monday, July 30, 2007 at 9am**. The bridge will reopen to traffic on **Wednesday, August 1 at 6pm**.

Work done during the three-day closure includes roadway striping, systems testing and painting the bridge underside.

Motorists should pay close attention to the Causeway Message Boards and Treasure Island residents can see closure information on TITV15. The City of Treasure Island web site also has current closure information. In addition, closing notifications are sent to subscribers of Treasure Island's e-notification system.

Opening ribbon-cutting ceremonies are Saturday, August 25, 2007 at 10am at the east end (the St. Petersburg side) of the bridge. Full details are available now at www.mytreasureisland.org. Click on the "Four Lanes of Freedom" logo on the homepage.

Notice to Mariners

Construction work at the Treasure Island Causeway Bridge will affect the accessibility of the channel to boaters. The **navigation channel at the Treasure Island Causeway Bridge is currently open at half-width**.

Mariners requesting information on the status of channel accessibility can call the Treasure Island Causeway Bridge Tender Control Room on channel 9.

Detour routes

Westbound traffic on the Treasure Island Causeway will be turned back at 79th Street to Causeway Boulevard North or South. Eastbound causeway traffic will detour at 104th Avenue, except for local traffic to the Treasure Island Yacht Club and Paradise Boulevard. Detour routes to and from Treasure Island during the bridge closure are the Madeira Beach Causeway to the north and the Corey Causeway in St. Pete Beach to the south.
