Another opportunity to pick-a-path linking Treasure Island with the Pinellas Trail

Citizens can join a discussion with the Treasure Island City Commission at a bike path community workshop March 19th

Share your ideas about the proposed bike path linking Treasure Island and the Pinellas Trail with the Treasure Island City Commission at a special "Bike Trail Community Workshop" on Thursday, March 19th at 6pm at the Treasure Island City Hall Auditorium, 120 108th Avenue.

Some of your ideas from the bike trail meeting last month have already been added to the various proposals. Up for discussion with the commission on the 19th are: routes through and/or around downtown Treasure Island; specific ways to improve streets and paths to provide safe and comfortable riding and walking experiences; funding sources and costs associated with the trail and any other concerns or issues regarding the bike trail.
