

# Residential Solid Waste Holiday Pickup Schedule Changes

Have you been confused by how the changes that City holidays occurring within the workweek affect your household solid waste pickup? Would you like to have a simple rule to follow when your solid waste hasn't been picked up because of the City holiday schedule?

Now you have one and here is how it works.

If a City holiday occurs during the week and it falls on your pickup day, your solid waste will be picked up the next day. If a City holiday falls the very day before your pickup day (with the exception of a Wednesday, as it is a off day for residential pickup), your pickup day will occur the day after your regular day. So in short, if your pickup is missed and there is a City holiday on or the day before your regular pickup day, your pickup day will occur one day later. The great part of this is there is no need to plan ahead to put your solid waste out early for City holidays that occur on a Thursday or Friday as was required before. Now, if you leave your solid waste at the curb on a day where it has not been picked up because of City holiday scheduling it will be picked up the next day.

The graphic below shows how the new holiday collection schedule works.

HOLIDAY

The exception to this rule will occur when Christmas falls on a Saturday. The City declares its employee holiday on Friday. Solid Waste Collection will occur on Friday as to avoid having collections occurring on the actual holiday. When this occurs, the same schedule will be followed the next week for the New Years day Holiday.

Note also that City holidays that fall on Wednesday have no affect on the schedule, as this day is not regularly scheduled for residential pickup
