

Maintain your ROLL-OUT CART in working order



Your new cart is designed for easy maintenance. To clean, simply rinse your cart with water from time to time, drain and let it dry in the sunlight with the lid open.

Don't use your ROLL-OUT CART for yard waste, junk & large appliances

All loose leaves, grass clippings, shrubbery, vines, moss, pine needles must be bagged for collection. Place yard waste at the curb, on your property, NOT in your roll-out cart. **Place yard waste, furniture, large junk items and large appliances together at the curb for collection by 7am on your normal collection day.**



Place your roll-out cart at the curb by **7am:**
MONDAYS & THURSDAYS

for addresses North of the Causeway

TUESDAYS & FRIDAYS

for addresses South of the Causeway and Paradise Lane

Your City of Treasure Island SOLID WASTE ROLL-OUT CART

In order to modernize waste collection to the residents of Treasure Island and reduce employee injuries, the city is introducing a fully automated refuse collection service. You can now dispose of household waste in a **city-provided 90-gallon container**, which is larger than a normal garbage can.



Each single family home will receive one 90-gallon roll-out cart at no charge. When placed at the curb for collection, a truck equipped with a specially designed mechanical arm will allow the operator to lift the roll-out cart off the street, empty it into the truck, and return the cart to its original position.

Our current method of collecting garbage exposes the homeowner and the garbage men to many hazards from heavy or worn out garbage cans. Often times, dogs, cats or the wind scatter

garbage placed at the curb. This creates an eyesore and health hazard.

The carts provided by the City of Treasure Island are strong, durable and have tight fitting, hinged lids. Attached wheels help the homeowner "roll out the trash" and automated lifting help the garbage men empty the cart. Both users benefit from the new system.

Frequently given ROLL-OUT CART answers

- You can purchase an additional cart for 1/2 the existing solid waste rate plus the initial cost of the cart. Call Public Works at 547-4575 ext. 250 for details.
- A police report is required to replace a stolen or vandalized roll-out cart at no charge. The TIPD number is 547-4595. A roll-out cart replaced due to customer negligence will be at the customer's expense.
- Each roll-out cart bears a serial number, which has been assigned a street address. **The cart stays with the house**, regardless of whether the resident sells or moves. The customer will be charged the cost of the cart if removed from the assigned property.

Loading your ROLL-OUT CART

Place all garbage and small junk items into bags; small junk items are clothes, books, papers, small electrical items and fallen fruit. All waste material placed in your cart must be bagged; then, lift the lid and place the bags into your cart.

Always close the lid. This will keep critters and rain out, refuse and odors in. **Your cart will not be emptied if it contains any of these items:** Paints, solvents, acid, gasoline, oil, hot ashes, medical wastes, sand, soil, rocks or concrete.



Moving your ROLL-OUT CART to the curb



Make sure the lid is closed. Then grab the handle and use the convenient "tilt and go" design feature (between the wheels at the rear of the cart) and TILT the cart back slightly. Now you can safely and easily push and pull the cart. Pull the cart uphill; push the cart downhill.

Setting your ROLL-OUT CART for collection

Place your cart at the curb or street as shown in the picture at right, the night before or by 7am the morning of your scheduled collection day. **THE FRONT OF YOUR CART SHOULD FACE THE STREET.** Don't place your cart close to obstructions such as fences, mailboxes, utility poles, trees or parked cars.



Remove your ROLL-OUT CART after collection



The City of Treasure Island requires your cart to be stored next to your home or in your garage, not at the curb. Store your cart away from furnaces, fireplaces, grills and other sources of excessive heat.
