

ORDINANCE 2020-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUILDING FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BUILDING DIVISION PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$78,000 FROM THE UNASSIGNED FUND BALANCE FOR CONTRACTUAL BUILDING SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2019-11, the City of Treasure Island, Florida adopted an annual operating budget for fiscal year 2020; and

WHEREAS, building activity has grown over the past 3 years in Treasure Island; and

WHEREAS, the City provides building services through a contractual relationship with a contracted provider; and

WHEREAS, additional funds in the amount of \$78,000 are estimated for building services through the end of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, this budget amendment will appropriate the \$78,000 from the unassigned fund balance within the Building Fund, which has a sufficient balance to fund this amendment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Charter and generally accepted accounting principles, the City of Treasure Island finds it in the public's interest to amend the City's budget to appropriate the funds in the Building Fund to continue to provide contractual building services to its' property owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The recitals set forth in the "Whereas" clauses above are ratified and confirmed as true and correct, and are hereby adopted as legislative findings by the City Commission of the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the adoption of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The General Fund Budget for the City of Treasure Island, Florida for the fiscal year 2020, as adopted pursuant to Ordinance 2019-11, is hereby amended to appropriate unassigned fund balance within the Building Fund in the amount of \$78,000 to fund the continuation of contractual building services through the fiscal year.

SECTION 3. That allocation of said funds shall be as follows:

From: unassigned fund balance of the Building Fund	\$78,000
To: 140-5241-34000 Contractual Services	\$78,000

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. It is declared to be the intent of the City Commission, that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for

any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5. CONFLICT. This action supersedes all ordinances and resolutions of the City or portions thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with this ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.

FIRST READING and PUBLIC HEARING on the 16th day of June, 2020.

SECOND READING and PUBLIC HEARING on the 21st day of July, 2020.


